Turn Claude Code or Codex into a cinematic motion-design studio

video-shotcraft is an agent skill that storyboards, animates, and sound-designs a cinematic promo video for your product using Remotion — real page captures, 2.5D camera moves, beat-synced cuts, and film-grade SFX included. Follow the six steps below and you'll have a finished film without touching a timeline.

01 Have your agent ready

This skill runs inside Claude Code or Codex. Install whichever you prefer, then open your project in it. Nothing else needs to be set up in advance.

02 Install the skill

The fastest route is to simply hand the repo link to your agent and let it install itself:

```
Install this skill for me:  
https://github.com/Vincentwei1021/video-shotcraft
```

Prefer the CLI?

```
npx skills add Vincentwei1021/video-shotcraft
```

Or clone and link it manually

```
git clone https://github.com/Vincentwei1021/video-shotcraft.git  
cd video-shotcraft  
ln -s "$(pwd)" ~/.claude/skills/video-shotcraft # Claude Code  
ln -s "$(pwd)" ~/.codex/skills/video-shotcraft # Codex
```

03 Browse the shot gallery

Every shot card and motion preview is browsable online — search, filter, compare variants, and copy the exact card names you want. You can paste this live URL straight into Claude Code so your agent can pull shots by name:

```
https://vincentwei1021.github.io/video-shotcraft/
```

04 Make your request

Once installed, just describe what you want in plain language:

```
Use video-shotcraft to create a promo for my desktop product.  
Use the deck-deal-flyin and row-embed shot cards for this feature.
```

Not sure where to start? The built-in Ink Press template is the most reliable path — a validated 36.2-second, 1920×1080, 30fps promo with 10 shots already tuned:

```
Use video-shotcraft to make a promo for my product  
with the Ink Press template.
```

If you don't name a shot card, the skill introduces Ink Press first and asks whether you'd like to use it.

05 Let it render

PLAN FOR THE WAIT

Video rendering takes around 40 minutes. Leave the agent running, go do something else, and check back once it's finished — this is normal, not a hang.

06 Swap in your own assets

The template ships with demonstration screenshots. Before you publish, replace them with your own product captures, copy, and branding — and double-check whether any customer or personal data on screen needs anonymizing.
